Answer all seven questions below as thoroughly as possible. Answer in complete sentences using good punctuation and spelling skills. Write neatly and remember to convince the reader of your answers.

1. Retell your favorite moment from the story. Include enough detail so that the reader can imagine what is taking place. Remember to explain WHY you chose this as your favorite part. (6-8 sentences)
2. In what way have you felt like a character in your story? First explain how your character felt in the story and tell exactly what happened to make that character feel that way. Then tell how you have felt that same way in your life and explain in great detail what happened to make you feel the same way. (6-8 sentences)
3. The plot or main idea is what the book is about. The plot is the problem in the story that your characters must solve. Explain the problem in your book. (3-4 sentences)
4. The climax of your story is how your characters solved the problem. Please explain how each of your characters helped to solve the problem that you explained in number 3. (6-8 sentences)
5. From a character description, a reader can determine how a character looks, thinks, and feels. Describe in detail your favorite character in this book. Explain how they look using information the author has given you. Also use support from your book to give examples of how your character thinks and feels.

6. A setting places a picture in your mind of where the story takes place. Choose one setting in your story and describe it in enough detail that the reader can picture it. Only choose one place from your story and tell me what it looks like and how it feels. (6-8 sentences)
7. What are your personal feelings about this book? What do you think? Did you like it? Why? (6-8 sentences)

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
